Team members included Sarah Manfred BSN, RN (UNC Health), Shedrak Morales endotech (Raleigh Endoscopy), Michael Dougherty, MD (UNC Health), Silpa Yalamanchili, MD (Raleigh Endoscopy), Nicholas Nickl, MD (retired, Lexington, KY), Sydney Greenberg, MD (UNC Health), and Leigh Hudnall, MD (UNC Health). Rounding out the team were GNCSGNA's board members, Aleta English MSN, RN, CGRN and Aileen Naro BSN, RN, CGRN, both of UNC Health. The team spent one week in

Guatemala and scoped for a total of three days. During that time 42 procedures were performed. These
