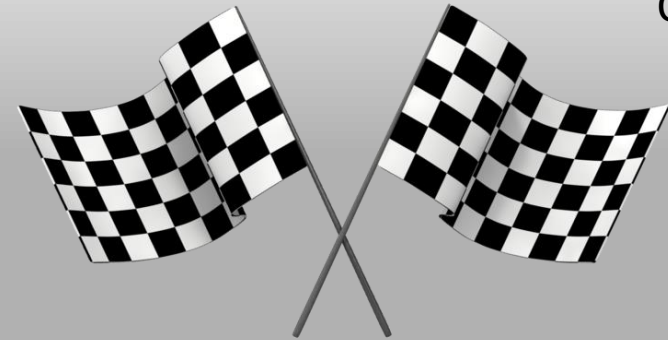

Wages typically start from **\$19,216** and go up to **\$38,017.**

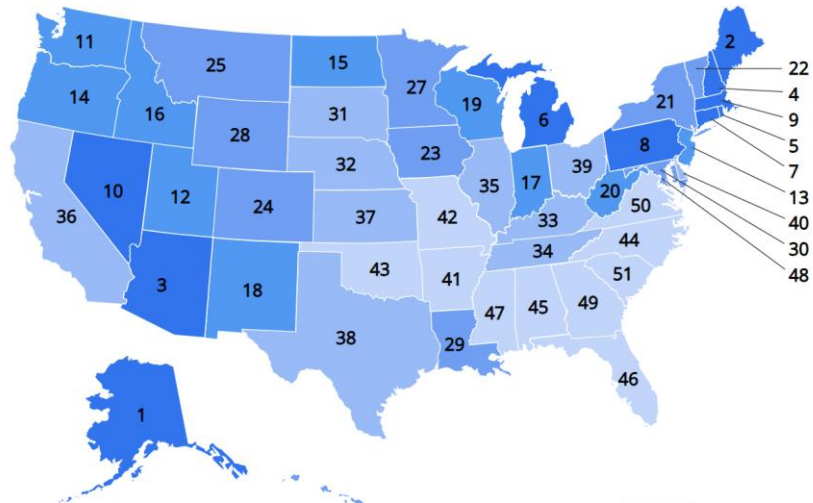
